The Howard County All Veterans Reunion will be at 8313 E. 400 S. Greentown, Indiana. The reunion will be September 12-18, 2022. Vendors must be closed down by noon Sunday, September 18, 2022. This reunion has both the 40th Vietnam Veterans Reunion and the 8th Sandbox Reunion combined.

You must complete & return the Vendor Agreement form along with payment. Booth space is reserved on a first come, first serve basis. If you have booth space preferences, we will make every effort to accommodate you. If you cannot attend after you have reserved a booth space, please let me know.

The Howard County Vietnam Veterans DO NOT REFUND MONEY for booth space unless the reunion is cancelled by our organization.

We have enclosed your Vendor Agreement form with a reminder that the Howard County Vietnam Veterans reserve the right to accept or reject any vendor. By signing the Vendor Agreement, you agree to abide by the vendor rules. **Vendor Agreement and payment must be to me by August 1, 2022.** Make sure the completed Vendor Agreement page 3 & 4 and payment by cashiers/bank check or money order (made out to Howard County Vietnam Veterans) are mailed to: Holly Tookolo, Reunion Vendor Chairman, 584 E. VENDOR RULES for Sept 12-18, 2022

1. Indemnify, defend and hold harmless Howard County Vietnam Veterans, Inc., its directors, officers, members, employees, agents, the city of Kokomo, the City of Greentown and it's contributors from any taxes, loss, injury or damage arising out or in connection with the Howard County All Veterans Reunion and including weather.
2. Assume sole responsibility for attending the Howard County All Veterans Reunion.
3. To comply with any and all rules set forth by Howard County Vietnam Veterans, Inc. and all city and state codes and regulations.
4. Merchandise items of military, patriotic or veteran related unless agreed to by the organization or its agents. Selling items outside the vendor area is expressly prohibited. The selling of fireworks is expressly prohibited. Selling raffle tickets or merchandise outside your booth space is prohibited.
5. Cannot sell any items pertaining or relating to Howard County Vietnam Veterans Organization or this reunion. Vendors found doing this will be removed from the property.
6. The Howard County Vietnam Veterans, Inc. will provide the overhead lights in the tent and adjoining building (Tookolo Hall). To supply additional electricity, the vendor will bring their own generator or can reserve and pay an additional \$50.00 to plug in ONLY ONE ITEM with one minimum 20 amp extension cord allowed to 20 amp breaker. You are not allowed to plug into the overhead lighting. The vendor must bring their own extension cords; you could be as far away as 200ft from the outlet so bring long cords. The vendor must be in accordance with fire codes; no combustible lighting shall be allowed. Any vendor found using additional electricity without reserving and paying for it, or found plugging in more than one extension cord, or found plugging in more than one item (such as a t-shirt press and a sewing machine) can be asked to leave the property. Using a generator is highly suggested.
7. The Howard County Vietnam Veterans, Inc. does not assume liability for any taxes, loss, theft, or damage to a vendor's merchandise or property. We do have security that patrols the area and stays in tent at night..
8. The Howard County Vietnam Veterans, Inc. agrees to refund all monies to said vendor only if the Howard County Vietnam Veterans Reunion is cancelled by the aforementioned organization.
9. Sharing of booth space with another vendor or organization is not allowed. Vendors found sharing their spaces with another vendor or organization will be required to pay an additional space fee or they will be asked to leave the property.
10. I will mail your parking pass closer to September. Please display the parking pass in vehicle window/dash.
11. We do not provide tables/chairs. To rent locally, two choices: Brian's Surplus 765-434-7637 or American Tool & Party Rental 888-453-6020.
12. Raffles – any Vendor conducting a raffle will have to provide the Gaming License for that raffle.
13. Not-for-Profit Status – Vendors need to provide necessary paperwork for Not-for-Profit status.
