If you need to run a generator past midnight for Health reasons, then you must be in reunion sites 600-1000 EAST. Inverter Generators run quieter and can be used on any reunion site 24 hours a day.

We cannot accept payment for reunion sites prior to February 1, 2025. Only HCVVO MEMBERS' reservations for reunion sites will be accepted from February 1st – Jun 1st, 2025.

After June 1st members reservations received without a prior Reunion Site Assignment will be processed as reunion sites become available. **(REMEMBER--- ONE LOT PER MEMBER ONLY)**

Reunion Site Reservation Fee: **maximum 8 nights** for early arrival beginning Sept 14, 2025 @ \$10 per night. **Minimum of 4 nights required, beginning Sept 17, 2025 @ \$10 per night.**

IMPORTANT INFORMATION WHICH MAY AFFECT YOUR REUNION SITE RESERVATION.

HCVVO REUNION SITE RULES

1. All reunion site renters are responsible for the appearance of their reunion sites. If needed trash bags are available
2. All reunion site fires must be contained, as we are responsible for any damage these fires cause to nearby fields and /or property. DO NOT burn skids with nails or items made of glass or metal and any non-burnable items, as these can cause serious injury to members/volunteers who clean up the fire pits.

OVERFLOW: NO REUNION SITE FIRES are allowed directly on the ground and must be contained in an appropriate above-ground vessel.

3. Generators will be turned off at midnight year-round unless you are in a generator permitted area and have medical needs. **Inverter Generators are permitted on all sites for 24-hour use, provided they do not exceed 65 decibels noise level.**
4. All radios will be turned down at 11pm Sun-Thurs and midnight Fri-Sat. After these times music should not be heard outside of your site without the approval of the reunion sites around you.
5. Pets must be on a leash or contained while on the grounds of HCVVO. No pets except SERVICE DOGS are allowed in the food or vending areas, around the trash or in the main building per the Board of Health and the Board of Officers of HCVVO. Please clean up after your pets.
6. All children under the age of 16 **must always be under adult supervision.**
7. Minibikes, scooters, ATV's, Golf Carts, and all motorized vehicles must be operated by a licensed driver who is at least 16 years of age. When operated after dark, vehicles must have lights, or you must carry a flashlight and have it turned on.
8. **Vehicles MUST be parked within the boundaries of your reunion site or in the West Field. Vehicles parked in unauthorized areas or creating safety concerns will be subject to towing at the owner's expense.**
9. **ANY/ALL FIREARMS will be secured in your RV/vehicle while on the property. NO weapon will be discharged ANYWHERE on HCVVO property or the OVERFLOW FIELD. ANYONE who BREAKS THIS RULE WILL BE BANNED FROM EVENTS FOREVER. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE!!!!**
10. Fireworks are prohibited. Again, we are not responsible for any damage caused by fireworks/fires.
11. Adults, please use alcohol responsibly. NO UNDERAGE DRINKING WILL BE ALLOWED. Illegal drugs will not be tolerated.
12. No fighting will be tolerated. Anyone who cannot conduct themselves in an orderly manner can and will be removed. THIS IS A HEALING FIELD, NOT A FIGHTING FIELD.
13. No vendor or raffle sales are permitted in the reunion site areas unless you have been granted an official fundraising permit with HCVVO.
14. No pets, alcohol or other drink, food or smoking is allowed in the Memorial Garden.
15. Anyone wishing to stay more than two (2) consecutive weeks at the grounds must get approval from the Board of Officers of HCVVO.
16. All RVs left on the grounds are to be moved to the West side parking lot by Oct 1st for winter. If HCVVO must move your RV as a result of your failure to move it after the reunion, then you will be charged a \$50.00 fee for gas and maintenance of vehicle used to move YOUR RV.

THESE RULES WILL BE IN EFFECT YEAR-ROUND, THE IGNORANCE OF THE RULES IS NOT AN EXCUSE!
